## WHEN JESUS ... Says Wait – May 5th 2024 – Pastor Peter

**Acts 1:3-5** “During the forty days after He suffered and died, He appeared to the apostles from time to time, and He proved to them in many ways that He was actually alive. And He talked to them about the Kingdom of God. Once when He was eating with them, He commanded them, ‘Do not leave Jerusalem but wait until the Father sends you the gift He promised, as I told you before. John baptized with water, but in just a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.’”

### 1. Wait In The Right Place

**Acts 1:4** “Don’t leave Jerusalem...”

It says, He commands them, ‘don’t leave Jerusalem’. He tells them to wait.’

There’s a right place for them to be to receive the promise and that right place is Jerusalem.

For us, there’s also a right place for us to wait to receive this and every promise from God.

Our right place is about a posture. Our right place is about the openness of our spirits. Our right place is about the attitude of our hearts.

**2 Corinthians 8:10** “So here’s what I think: The best thing you can do right now is to finish what you started last year and not let those good intentions grow stale. Your heart’s been in the right place all along.”
